Media 4 Humanity is an organization of media professionals and students helping disadvantaged children. We run a national STOP child-trafficking campaign and also local literacy, sports, and self-esteem building programs for at-risk children. We are nonprofit and nonpartisan.

Media 4 Humanity will hire between five to seven interns this semester though our summer internship program is one of the largest internship programs in the nation.
