



ST. JOHN'S LAW REVIEW

PUBLICATION CONTRACT

In consideration for the publication by the *St. John's Law Review* ("the *Law Review*") of an article written by [AUTHOR NAME] ("the Author"), entitled "[ARTICLE NAME]," scheduled to appear in [Volume __, Issue __] of the *Law Review*, the Author makes the following representations and agreements:

A. REPRESENTATIONS

1. The Author is the sole author and proprietor of the Article. If the Author is not the sole author, the Author has obtained any necessary permission from co-authors to enter into this agreement and will deliver such written permission to the *Law Review*.
2. The Author has full power to enter into this agreement and to grant the rights herein.
3. The Article has not previously been published, in whole or in part.
4. The Article does not infringe any statutory copyright or any contractual rights of third parties.
5. The Article does not invade the right of privacy of any third person, or contain any matter libelous or otherwise in contravention of the rights of any third person and all statements in the Article asserted as facts are true or are based upon reasonable research for accuracy.

B. AGREEMENTS

1. The Author agrees that failure by the Author to comply with the above Representations will be considered a breach of the Publication Contract; upon such breach, the *Law Review* may require reasonable proof of conformance with the Representations, and if the Author refuses to provide proof of conformance the *Law Review* may terminate the publication agreement.
2. The Author assigns to the *Law Review* the non-exclusive right to reproduce and distribute the Article in whole or in part and to publish and sell off-prints of the Article.
3. The Author grants to the *Law Review* the non-exclusive right to authorize the publication, reproduction, and distribution of the Article in electronic media, computerized retrieval systems, and similar information dissemination systems, and to transfer such rights.
4. The Author acknowledges the right of the *Law Review* to reproduce the Article or portions thereof in any compilation or collective work based on *Law Review* publications, including re-editions of the same issue in which the Article first appeared.
5. The Author agrees that the Article may be reproduced by interested parties for educational purposes, provided that the reproductions are distributed at or below cost, the Author and the *Law Review* are identified on each copy, and proper notice of copyright is affixed to each copy.
6. The assignment of any rights to the *Law Review* shall not be construed as diminishing the Author's own right to publish and sell off-prints of the Article, or to publish the Article elsewhere, provided that the Author agrees to credit the *Law Review* with first publication.

7. The Author agrees to conform to the *Law Review* editorial deadlines. The Author further agrees that failure by the Author to conform to the *Law Review* editorial deadlines may be treated as a breach of the Publication Contract; upon such breach the *Law Review* may choose to publish the article in a later issue.
