



Fast Facts Fall 2008

- Total enrollment **20,109**
 - 14,816 Undergraduate Students
 - 5,293 Graduate Students
- **3,268** New Freshmen - largest number ever enrolled
- Students come from **44** States, District of Columbia, Guam, Puerto Rico, US Virgin Islands and **122** countries
- **1,236** Non-resident (International) Students, the largest number ever enrolled, come from **102** countries

- **57%** Female
- **48%** Roman Catholic
- **40%** are Black, Hispanic, Asian/Pacific Islander or Native American
- Approximately **3,500** students live in residence facilities on and around the Queens, Staten Island and Manhattan campuses
- **3,925** degrees conferred during the 2007-2008 academic year
- UG tuition — **\$28,100** (varies by program and class year)
- **97%** of undergraduates receive financial aid
- **\$357.6** million distributed in Financial Aid
- **Over 3,200** employees
 - Full-time Faculty – **696**
